Inside

The epitome of country-living-on-sea, Little Fentafriddle boasts staggering ocean views beyond verdant cliff-top fields. This luxury five star coastal cottage in North Cornwall can be hired out exclusively for four.

Perfect for a family getaway or a romantic break, Little Fentafriddle is the ideal retreat for beach lovers, walkers and foodie aficionados.

- **Style:** Newly renovated to offer a traditional cottage-feel finished with stylish, contemporary décor and all mod cons; luxurious details include a wood-burning stove, squishy sofas, an open-plan living area, en suite bathrooms and a country kitchen.
- **Bedrooms:** One kingsize double and one twin/double, both en suite, are bedecked in country-cottage style luxury.
- **For relaxation:** Enjoy breathtaking sunsets from the terrace or sink into a plump sofa and toast your toes by the wood-burner.
- **For recreation:** A full-scale entertainment centre is hidden behind cupboard doors (so it doesn't interrupt the 'away from it all' setting unless you want it to).
- **Practicalities:** Eco-friendly elements: all water comes from boreholes, geothermal under floor heating and guests are encouraged to separate recyclable rubbish. Dishwasher and washer/dryer. Parking for two cars.

Outside

- In a secluded, elevated position surrounded by 50-acres of private farmland, the grounds offer panoramic views of the North Cornish coast from Tintagel to Trevoze Head. French doors lead out onto the terrace and gardens from where you can take in stunning scenery while enjoying a sundowner or alfresco dining.

Please note additional accommodation is located within the grounds along with the main Farmhouse, which is occupied by the owners, and guests may be in residence during your stay.

Food and Wine

- **DIY:** The kitchen is equipped with everything you need to host lavish dinner parties. The living area opens out to a terrace with floodlights and a barbecue for alfresco entertainment. Enhance your self-catered stay by adding bubbles and chocolates, a cream tea or fresh picnic from Unique Boutique.
- **In-house cuisine:** Catering is available at an additional cost and is to be arranged direct with the caterers. We are able to provide you with contacts for recommended caterers on request.
- **Eating out:** In the heart of one of the UK's favourite foodie destinations you are spoilt for choice when it comes down to eating out. On the doorstep at Trebarwith Strand the Port William pub is fantastically positioned overlooking the rugged beach, whilst nearby in Port Isaac is the family owned The Harbour Restaurant. A short drive further south in Padstow you'll find Rick Stein's cluster of eateries. Head further south and onto Jamie Oliver's Fifteen Cornwall overhanging the golden sands at Watergate Bay.
- **Wine:** follow the Camel Estuary as it winds its way up to Camel Valley vineyard and spend a while sampling some of Cornwall's most infamous bubbly, a real Cornish success story.

Getting there

- **On the map:** Situated between Port Isaac and Tintagel, a couple of miles inland from Trebarwith

Stand on the North Cornish coast.

- By car: About 5.5 hours from London
- By train: The nearest train station is Bodmin, about half an hour away.
- Helipad: Helicopter landing site at Trebarwith (HLS)

Out and About

- Don your walking boots – the South West Coast Path is on the doorstep.
- Visit the classic Cornish fishing village of Port Isaac, from where you can head out on a fishing trip or buy fresh seafood from the harbour.
- Learn to surf at Trebarwith Strand – about 20 minutes walk away
- Play golf at one of many superb courses nearby, including St Enodoc, Roserrow, Bowood Park and St Kew.
